## New & Unique Amethyst

We recently acquired some incredibly special and rare amethyst formations from Brazil, alongside a bevy of beautiful new amethyst geodes from Brazil and Uruguay.



These formations are known as amethyst pines because of the pine-like growth structure of the crystal. They are also what is referred to as “druzy” amethyst due to the large quantity of small individual points. Some of these pieces also feature white calcite growing alongside amethyst. We encourage you to come into the gallery and feel the soft and calming energy that radiates from all of our new Amethyst specimens.

## Updated Mask Policy

The White California Sage bundles we carry are excellent tools for clearing and cleansing the energy of a room. To extend the lifespan of your sage we recommend you unwrap your bundle and burn each leaf or sprig as needed. We recommend using a feather to disperse the smoke from your sage as you walk clockwise around the room. As you are walking, focus on negative energies leaving the room. Feel free to set an intention for the space as you finish clearing it. We like to invoke abundance and prosperity each morning when we sage the gallery.
